FOSTERING ACTIVE LEARNING IN YOUR CLASSROOM

How can we make lectures more interactive and more geared towards higher-level learning? 'Active learning' approaches form a key alternative. Simply put, active learning is the process of learning by engaging with the content. It means students interact with the material in ways that can promote active thinking, via 'activities' for learning or via re-framing the note-taking process to encourage thinking about the material rather than transcribing the content.

TEACHING BILINGUAL SUBJECTS USING CLIL

Teaching a bilingual subject can be a challenge. Transforming your lessons using the CLIL approach will help you deal with common issues in this field. It can increase your students' motivation to learn what you're teaching them. Besides, as it is so strongly associated with both a content area and a foreign language, it's naturally imbued with cultural and societal significance.

Do you want to expand your knowledge regarding how to properly write and proofread a scientific paper? This course will grant you access to linguistic tools to outline and revise your future publications and judge whether they are ready for submission.

INTERCULTURALITY IN THE CLASSROOM

With the influx of international students as well as the increase in COIL exchanges, how can we as professors, capitalize on the opportunity to open space so that our students maximize not only discipline-centered learnings but also intercultural competencies? In this course, we will enhance our understanding as to how culture & diversity shape our verbal and non-verbal communication styles; how we prefer to persuade; our cultural preferences for providing and receiving feedback; our inclinations around how we structure our time and our schedules; as well as our approaches to power, authority, and hierarchies. We will then harness Project Based Learning (PBL) to implement our newfound knowledge of intercultural communication and global competencies into a COIL encounter in our classrooms.

ASSESSMENT AND FEEDBACK TOOLS FOR ENGLISH TAUGHT COURSES

While there are many tools and strategies, there are certainly some specific ones that stand out. Besides, you will learn how to complement your assessment tools with effective feedback.

AUTHENTIC MATERIAL DESIGN

What are authentic materials? How can we create them? Why are they important in our lessons? Those questions will be answered while you create your own ones. The use of authentic materials in your classroom is strongly suggested as they have a positive impact on the students' subject-knowledge and motivation.
